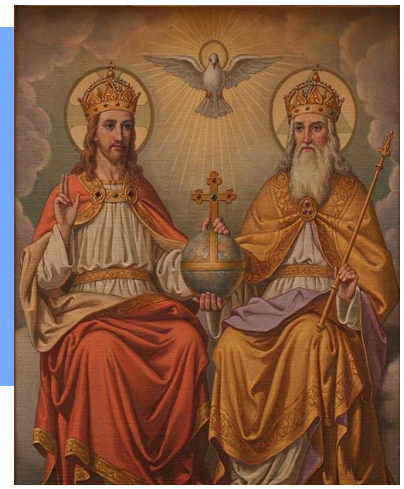

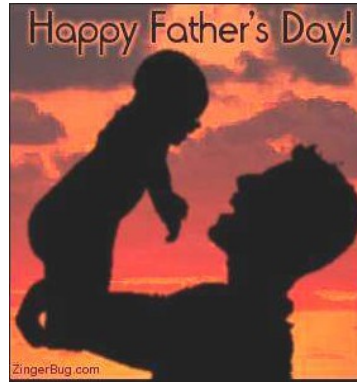

The Shroud of Turin is a centuries old linen cloth that bears the image of a crucified man. A man that millions believe to be Jesus of Nazareth. It is, in fact, the single most studied artifact in human history, and we know more about it today than we ever have before. And yet, the controversy still rages. The visitor walks through 12 chambers through the history of the object most studied: The Shroud of Turin. From the finding of the Shroud and its hidden negative, the visitor will see and discover the history, science, controversy, and facts surrounding the Shroud of Turin.

From the letter of St. Paul to the Romans,

11:25-36

رسالة القديس بولس إلى أهل رومة

يا إخوتي،
لا أريد، أيها الإخوة، أن تجهلوا هذا السرّ، لئلا تكونوا حكماء في عُيون أنفسكم، وهو أنّ التصلّب أصاب قسماً من بني إسرائيل، إلى أن يؤمن الأمم بأكملهم. وهكذا يخلص جميع بني إسرائيل، كما هو مكتوب: «من صهيون يأتي المنقذ، ويردّ الكفر عن يعقوب؛ وهذا هو عهدي معهم، حين أزيل خطاياهم.» «فهم من جهة الإنجيل أعداء من أجلكم، أمّا من جهة اختيار الله، فهم أحبّاء من أجل الآباء؛ لأنّ الله لا يترّاجع أبداً عن مواهبه ودعوته. فكما عصيتم الله أنتم في ما مضى، ورجمتم الآن من جرّاء عصيانهم، كذلك هم الآن عصوا الله من أجل رحمتكم، لكي يرحموا الآن هم أيضاً؛ لأنّ الله قد حبس جميع الناس في العصيان، لكي يرحم الجميع. فبما لعمق عني الله وحكمته ومعرفته! ما أبعد أحكامه عن الإدراك، وطرقه عن الاستقصاء! فمن عرف فكر الربّ؟ أو من صار له مشيراً؟ أو من أقرضه شيئاً فبرّده الله إليه؟ لأنّ كلّ شيء منه وبه وإليه. له المجد إلى الدهور. أمين.

Brothers and sisters,

So that you may not claim to be wiser than you are, I want you to understand this mystery: a hardening has come upon part of Israel, until the full number of the Gentiles has come in. And so all Israel will be saved; as it is written, “Out of Zion will come the Deliverer; he will banish ungodliness from Jacob.” “And this is my covenant with them, when I take away their sins.” As regards the gospel they are enemies of God for your sake; but as regards election they are beloved, for the sake of their ancestors; for the gifts and the calling of God are irrevocable. Just as you were once disobedient to God but have now received mercy because of their disobedience, so they have now been disobedient in order that, by the mercy shown to you, they too may now receive mercy. For God has imprisoned all in disobedience so that he may be merciful to all. O the depth of the riches and wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are his judgments and how inscrutable his ways! “For who has known the mind of the Lord? Or who has been his counselor?” “Or who has given a gift to him, to receive a gift in return?” For from him and through him and to him are all things. To him be the glory forever. Amen.
