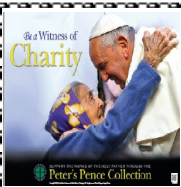

**THE HOSPITALS DO NOT
NOTIFY US.**

On **June 29** the Church celebrates the **feast day of Sts. Peter & Paul**. As early as the year 258, there is evidence of an already lengthy tradition of celebrating the solemnities of both Saint Peter and Saint Paul on the same day. Together, the two saints are the founders of the See of Rome, through their preaching, ministry and martyrdom there.

Peter, who was named Simon, was a fisherman of Galilee and was introduced to the Lord Jesus by his brother Andrew, also a fisherman. Jesus gave him the name Cephas (Petrus in Latin), which means 'Rock,' because he was to become the rock upon which Christ would build His Church.

Peter was a bold follower of the Lord. He was the first to recognize that Jesus was "the Messiah, the Son of the living God," and eagerly pledged his fidelity until death. In his boldness, he also made many mistakes, however, such as losing faith when walking on water with Christ and betraying the Lord on the night of His passion. Yet despite his human weaknesses, Peter was chosen to shepherd God's flock. The Acts of the Apostles illustrates his role as head of the Church after the Resurrection and Ascension of Christ. Peter led the Apostles as the first Pope and ensured that the disciples kept the true faith.

St. Peter spent his last years in Rome, leading the Church through persecution and eventually being martyred in the year 64. He was crucified upside-down at his own request, because he claimed he was not worthy to die as his Lord. He was buried on Vatican hill, and St. Peter's Basilica is built over his tomb.

St. Paul was the Apostle of the Gentiles. His letters are included in the writings of the New Testament, and through them we learn much about his life and the faith of the early Church. Before receiving the name Paul, he was Saul, a Jewish pharisee who zealously persecuted Christians in Jerusalem. Scripture records that Saul was present at the martyrdom of St. Stephen. Saul's conversion took place as he was on his way to Damascus to persecute the Christian community there. As he was traveling along the road, he was suddenly surrounded by a great light from heaven. He was blinded and fell off his horse. He then heard a voice saying to him, "Saul, Saul, why do you persecute me?" He answered: "Who are you, Lord?" Christ said: "I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting."

Saul continued to Damascus, where he was baptized and his sight was restored. He took the name Paul and spent the remainder of his life preaching the Gospel tirelessly to the Gentiles of the Mediterranean world.

Paul was imprisoned and taken to Rome, where he was beheaded in the year 67. He is buried in Rome in the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls.

In a sermon in the year 395, St. Augustine of Hippo said of Sts. Peter and Paul: "Both apostles share the same feast day, for these two were one; and even though they suffered on different days, they were as one. Peter went first, and Paul followed. And so we celebrate this day made holy for us by the apostles' blood. Let us embrace what they believed, their life, their labors, their sufferings, their preaching, and their confession of faith."

From the letter of St. Paul to the Corinthians,

يا إخوتي،

أهم عبرانيون؟ أنا أيضاً عبراني! أهم: أقول وأحجل، كما لو كنا ضُعفاء! وأقول كجاهل: إن كل ما يجزؤ عليه هؤلاء، أجرؤ عليه أنا أيضاً أهم خدام للمسيح؟ أقول كمن فقد صوابه: أنا أكثر! في الاتعاب! إسرائيليون؟ أنا أيضاً إسرائيليين! أهم نسل إبراهيم؟ أنا أيضاً نسل إبراهيم تلقيت الجلد من اليهود خمس مرات، كل مرة أكثر! في السجون أكثر! في الضربات أكثر جداً! في أخطار الموت أكثر بمرات كثيرة ضربت بالعصي ثلاث مرات! رجمت مرة واحدة! أنكسرت بي السفينة ثلاث مرات! قضيت في عرض البحر ليلة! أربعين جلدة إلا واحدة قمت بأسفار كثيرة، كنت في أخطار من الأنهار، أخطار من اللصوص، أخطار من أممي، أخطار من الأمم، أخطار في المدينة، ونهاراً عانيت التعب، والكذب، والسهر مرات كثيرة، والجوع، والعطش، أخطار في الصحراء، أخطار في البحر، أخطار بين الإخوة الكذبة من يضعف ولا أضغف! أضف إلى ذلك، ما علي من الأعباء كل يوم، والأهتمام بجميع الكنائس! والصوم مرات كثيرة، والبرد، والعري أنا؟ ومن يقع في الخطيئة ولا احترق أنا؟ وإن كان لا بد من الأفتخار، فأنا أفتخر بأوهاني!.

Brothers and sisters,

To my shame, I must say, we were too weak for that! But whatever anyone dares to boast of — I am speaking as a fool — I also dare to boast of that. Are they Hebrews? So am I. Are they Israelites? So am I. Are they descendants of Abraham? So am I. Are they ministers of Christ? I am talking like a madman — I am a better one: with far greater labors, far more imprisonments, with countless floggings, and often near death. Five times I have received from the Jews the forty lashes minus one. Three times I was beaten with rods. Once I received a stoning. Three times I was shipwrecked; for a night and a day I was adrift at sea; on frequent journeys, in danger from rivers, danger from bandits, danger from my own people, danger from Gentiles, danger in the city, danger in the wilderness, danger at sea, danger from false brothers and sisters; in toil and hardship, through many a sleepless night, hungry and thirsty, often without food, cold and naked. And, besides other things, I am under daily pressure because of my anxiety for all the churches. Who is weak, and I am not weak? Who is made to stumble, and I am not indignant? If I must boast, I will boast of the things that show my weakness. **Praise be to God always!**

The evangelist Matthew writes,

When Jesus came into the district of Caesarea Philippi, he asked his disciples, “Who do people say that the Son of Man is?” And they said, “Some say John the Baptist, but others Elijah, and still others Jeremiah or one of the prophets.” He said to them, “But who do you say that I am?” Simon Peter answered, “You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God.” And Jesus answered him, “Blessed are you, Simon son of Jonah! For flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but my Father in heaven. And I tell you, you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church, and the gates of Hades will not prevail against it. I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth will be loosed in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven.” Then he sternly ordered the disciples not to tell anyone that he was the Messiah.

This is the truth! Peace be with you.

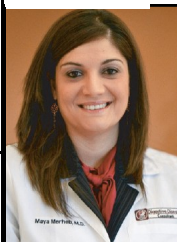
