“Seek and you will find.” Mt 7:7

Two weeks ago, I wrote about the first three thresholds of becoming an “intentional disciple”: (1) “initial trust”, (2) “spiritual curiosity”, and (3) “spiritual openness” from the book *Forming Intentional Disciples* by Sherry Weddel. This week I would like to write about the final two stages which involve conversion and change of life: (4) “spiritual seeking” and (5) “intentional discipleship.” “Spiritual seeking” is the first **active** stage where one seeks/ tries/ struggles/ endeavors to know God. It is an urgent spiritual quest to see if God is worthy of all your heart, mind, soul, strength or not. The spiritual seeker will spend regular time in prayer, in study, and in holy conversation. Weddel suggests that to move from openness to seeking one should go to confession, do works of charity and mercy, and try out multiple forms of prayer (meditating on scripture, praying liturgical prayers, speaking short prayers throughout the day, speaking to God while walking, recited prayer devotions, adoration, etc.). In my experience, I have likewise witnessed that love of prayer and charity often comes after one begins and not before. People around the seeker might find the seeker annoying because they are beginning to come “single minded” or one track mind, “is Jesus the one for whom I should give everything?”

The seeker then comes to a point where he or she has enough evidence and input to proceed or turn back. The seeker has a decision to make, “do I give all, do I become an intentional disciple?” “Intentional discipleship” is what Jesus is describing in Matthew 13:45-46 where the merchant sells all that he has to buy the pearl of great price. It is the love Jesus speaks about in John 15:13 “to lay down one’s life for one’s friend”. The apostles and saints were intentional disciples. St. Marina wanted nothing, but God and left the world for the monastery. St. John Paul II embraced the world, but likewise gave himself entirely for God.

Yet, intentional discipleship is not meant only for saints, nor only for popes and nuns, but is a normal maturity of the normal Christian life.

SAINT MARON Healer of Bodies and Souls

St. Maron (ca 345-410) lived the life of an ascetic, at a hill top where an ancient temple to the Babylonian god Nabo stood, which he converted to a Christian church. His hermit lifestyle was characterized as living "in the open air." Where he resided, the summers were very hot and the winters very cold, but he was willing to be exposed to these extremes in order to focus on his spiritual goals and overcome concerns for his body.



A record of St. Maron's life comes to us from St. Theodoret (393-457)

I shall recall Maron, for he too adorned the godly choir of the saints. Embracing the open-air life, he repaired to a hill-top formerly honored by the impious. Consecrating to God the precinct of demons on it, he lived there, pitching a small tent which he seldom used. He practiced not only the usual labors, but devised others as well, heaping up the wealth of philosophy.

The Umpire measured out grace according to his labors: so the magnificent one gave in abundance the gift of healing, with the result that his fame circulated everywhere, attracted everyone from every side and taught by experience the truth of the report. One could see fevers quenched by the dew of his blessing, shivering quieted, demons put to flight, and varied diseases of every kind cured by a single remedy; the progeny of physicians apply to each disease the appropriate remedy, but the prayer of the saint is a common antidote for every distress.

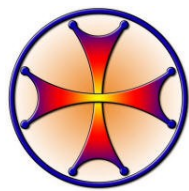


