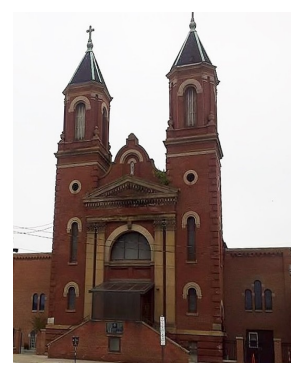


SUNDAY OF THE ENTRANCE INTO LENT ST. MARON MARONITE CATHOLIC CHURCH February 26, 2017



In reading the scriptures, theologians before us have seen that the importance given to the Eucharist in the liturgy matches the importance given to the Eucharist in the Sacred Scriptures.

One such example of the Eucharist in the Bible is the image of a covenant meal. In Genesis 31:43-54 terms of peace are reached after Jacob, the grandson of Abraham, is caught by someone Jacob thinks is his enemy. The peace takes the form of a covenant for the two families to become one family. The covenant is confirmed by a sacrifice offered to God and a meal shared between the two parties.

We see a similar covenant between God and Moses, Aaron and 72 elders of Israel in Exodus 24:1-12 here Moses offers a sacrifice on behalf of the people and because of it the whole group “beheld God, and they ate and drank.”

Now an important aspect of a covenant meal is that the meal that is eaten is part of the sacrifice and comes from the sacrifice. So if oxen are sacrificed, then beef from those oxen are consumed in the meal and the people take part in the sacrifice and the covenant is said to be witnessed and confirmed by God.

We see echoes of a covenant meal in a wedding, where a covenant of marriage includes a meal witnessing the two families becoming one.

In the New Testament, we encounter the Lord’s Supper (Matthew 26:17-30) where Jesus shares a meal with his disciples. The meal is on the anniversary of the great covenant of Passover (Exodus 12) where a lamb was sacrificed and the people shared a covenant meal with God. On this night Jesus says, “take, eat; this is my body.” Then he took a cup, and after giving thanks he gave it to them, saying, “Drink from it, all of you; for this is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins.” Jesus sees the supper as a covenant meal and in a covenant meal, one eats the flesh of the sacrificed lamb.

In the Lord’s Supper Jesus is the lamb who is to be sacrificed on the Cross as a covenant sacrifice and “the body and blood of Our Lord Jesus Christ” as we say at communion are the covenant meal. So in the covenant meal of the Eucharist, we are the family of God and as in Exodus 24 we are able to “behold God.”

When we approach the Eucharist, let us approach with faith that Jesus has done what he promised, that He has made a covenant between God and man by giving us Himself.

Lenten Regulations on Fast and Abstinence:

Ash Monday marks the beginning of Lent. The
following fasting and abstinence
regulations are observed:

Abstinence from meat is observed on
Ash Monday, Good Friday, and all the Fridays of
Lent by all Catholics 14 years of age and older.

All Maronites who are physically
capable are to abstain from meat on Ash
Monday (February 27) and all Fridays of Lent.

**Ash Monday and the Great Friday of
the Crucifixion are also days of fasting.**
**Fasting in the Maronite Church involves
eating and drinking nothing at all (except
water and medicine) from midnight until
noon.** The rest of the day normal meals can be
taken but without meat. All Maronites who are
physically capable are to fast on these two
days.

**During Lent, the Church encourages
regular attendance at Sunday Liturgy,
self-imposed times of fasting, and generosity
to local, national, and worldwide programs
of sharing.**

From the letter of St. Paul to the Romans,

14:14-23

يا إخوتي،
 إني عالمٌ وواثقٌ، في الربِّ يسوع، أن لا شيء نجسٌ في ذاته، إلا لمن يحسبُه نجسًا، فله يكون نجسًا.
 فإن كنت من أجل الطعام تحزن أخاك، فلا تكون سالكًا في المحبة. فلا تهلك بطعامك ذلك الذي مات المسيح من أجله!
 إذا فلا تسمحوا بأن يصير الخبز فيكم سببًا للتجديف.
 فليس ملكوت الله أكلًا وشربًا، بل برٌّ وسلامٌ وفرحٌ في الروح القدس.

Brothers and sisters,

I know and am persuaded in the Lord Jesus that nothing is unclean in itself; but it is unclean for anyone who thinks it unclean. If your brother or sister is being injured by what you eat, you are no longer walking in love. Do not let what you eat cause the ruin of one for whom Christ died.

So do not let your good be spoken of as evil. For the kingdom of God is not food and drink but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit. The one who thus serves Christ is acceptable to God and has human approval. Let us then pursue what makes for peace and for mutual up building. Do not, for the sake of food, destroy the work of God. Everything is indeed clean, but it is wrong for you to make others fall by what you eat; it is good not to eat meat or drink wine or do anything that makes your brother or sister stumble. The faith that you have, have as your own conviction before God. Blessed are those who have no reason to condemn themselves because of what they approve. But those who have doubts are condemned if they eat, because they do not act from faith; for whatever does not proceed from faith is sin.

The evangelist writes,

On the third day there was a wedding in Cana of Galilee, and the mother of Jesus was there. Jesus and his disciples had also been invited to the wedding. When the wine gave out, the mother of Jesus said to him, "They have no wine." And Jesus said to her, "Woman, what concern is that to you and to me? My hour has not yet come."

His mother said to the servants, "Do whatever he tells you." Now standing there were six stone water jars for the Jewish rites of purification, each holding twenty or thirty gallons. Jesus said to them, "Fill the jars with water." And they filled them up to the brim. He said to them, "Now draw some out, and take it to the chief steward." So they took it. When the steward tasted the water that had become wine, and did not know where it came from (though the servants who had drawn the water knew), the steward called the bridegroom and said to him, "Everyone serves the good wine first, and then the inferior wine after the guests have become drunk. But you have kept the good wine until now." Jesus did this, the first of his signs, in Cana of Galilee, and revealed his glory; and his disciples believed in him.

This is the truth! Peace be with you.
