

HEALING OF THE BLIND MAN

I love the Psalms. Their rich diversity surprises me, their humanity encourages me, and their beauty comforts me. Many have memorized Psalms and recited them by heart in times of despair, anger, fear, or joy. Jesus prayed the Psalms and even recited a verse while on the cross.

The shortest Psalm, Psalm 117, is a prayer of praise, reassurance, and faith.

*Praise the Lord all you peoples,
glorify him all you nations
for steadfast is his mercy toward us
and the truth of the Lord endures forever.*

This is a Psalm easy to say in good times and transformative to say in hard times. God's mercy is steadfast regardless of our circumstance, actions, or fate. Psalm 51 is a heartfelt repentance. It begins:

*Have mercy on me, O God, in your goodness;
in the greatness of your compassion
wipe out my offense.
Thoroughly wash me from my guilt
and of my sin cleanse me.
For I acknowledge my offense,
and my sin is before me always:*

This Psalm is attributed to King David after he committed adultery and murder. He was confronted by the prophet (2 Samuel 12) and repented. This Psalm encourages a repentance and conversion unto transformation of life which begins with reliance on and trust in the mercy of God. The Psalm begins sorrowfully, but full of hope.

*O LORD, open my lips,
and my mouth shall proclaim your praise. (Psalm 51:15).*

A favorite refrain of mine, for its humanity is "How long, Lord?" (See Psalms 6, 13, 90, 94)

I imagine this Psalm first prayed in hopeful anger. It is as if the writer is praying, "Bad things are happening and I need you, O God, and how much longer must I wait?"

This refrain reminds me of a favorite Maronite hymn:

In expectations and trials, our souls praise you. Like the five virgins behold our lamps, the wind lashes at our burning lamps, our hope, our faith, and our love are fading. O desire of my soul it is to you that I cry. When will the bridal party come, already my spirit is weakening?

In joys and in sorrows the Psalms teach us to pray honestly and earnestly to the Lord, trusting in Him, that steadfast is his mercy toward us.

Look at what confronts you. Whoever is confident of belonging to Christ should consider that as he belongs to Christ, so do we. **Praise be to God always!**

He threw aside his cloak, sprang up, and came to Jesus. Jesus said to him in reply, "What do you want me to do for you?" The blind man replied to him, "Master, I want to see." Jesus told him, "Go your way; your faith has saved you." Immediately he received his sight and followed him on the way. **This is the truth! Peace be with you.**


