

THIRD SUNDAY OF THE RESURRECTION

ST. MARON MARONITE CATHOLIC CHURCH

April 30, 2017

When we die, how do we want Jesus to greet us? Shall He say to us, as He said to the two disciples, "Oh, how foolish you are!" (Luke 24:25) Indeed in many ways we are foolish. We doubt the Resurrection by our actions. We fear death and suffering and often fail to persevere. These two disciples were excited by the wonders that had happened, yet they left Jerusalem and the church. Were they scandalized by the death of Jesus, afraid for themselves? Were they abandoning the church because of the sins of Judas and Peter and the weakness of most of the Twelve? Were they bored or concerned about some earthly affair to which they must attend?

Jesus walks with them, and teaches them, but it is not his words that change the two disciples. The two would later speak of their hearts burning within them, but it was not their emotions that changed them. Rather it was in action, in the breaking of the bread. In the breaking of the bread we see the Lord's supper or the Eucharist and we also see the Passion and death of Jesus. This action cause a literal conversion (Latin: convertere to turn around) whereby the two disciples return to the church, and to the no good and weak leaders, and to the unenthusiastic members, to proclaim to them by their words and by their transformation that Jesus is risen. Jesus shows them his death and they are brought to life. One of the major secrets to understanding the faith is that life comes through death, and that greatness comes through self sacrifice. When one realizes that those positions of the Church that we think of as foolish become life-giving deaths and in embracing uncomfortable truths, and living an uncomfortable life we find greatness.

If we pass from this world, thus transformed, we will not hear Jesus say, "Oh, how foolish you are!" but rather, "Oh, you who have died with me, live now with me?" (Cf. 2 Timothy 2:11)

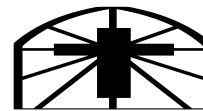

The saying is sure: If we have died with him, we will also live with him; if we endure, we will also reign with him; if we deny him, he will also deny us; if we are faithless, he remains faithful —for he cannot deny himself.

في اليوم عينه، كان اثنان من التلاميذ ذاهبين إلى قرية تدعى عماوس، تبعد نحو سبعة أميال عن اورشليم. وكانا يتحادثان بكل تلك الأمور التي حدثت. وفيما هما يتحادثان ويتساءلان، إذا يسوع قد اقترب منهما، وراح يسير معهما. ولكن أعينهما أمسكت عن معرفته. أما هو فقال لهما: «ما هذا الكلام الذي تتحادثان به، وأنتما تسييران؟» فوفقا غابسين. وأجاب أحدهما، وأسمه كليوباس، فقال له: «هل أنت وحدك غريب عن اورشليم، فلا تعلم ما حدث فيها هذه الأيام؟» فقال لهما: «وما هي؟» فقالا له: «ما يتعلق بيسوع الناصري، الذي كان رجلاً نبياً قوياً بالقول والفعل، فقام الله والشعب كله. وكيف أسلمه أخبارنا ورؤسائنا ليحكم عليه بالموت، وكيف صلبوه! وكنا نحن نرجو أن يكون هو الذي سيؤدي إسرائيل. ولكن مع هذا كله، فهذا هو اليوم الثالث بعد تلك الأحداث. لكن بغض النساء من جماعتنا أدهشتنا، لأنهن ذهبن إلى القبر عند الفجر، ولم يجدن جسد يسوع، فرجعن وقلن إنهن شاهدن ملائكة نراهن وقالوا إنه حي! ومضى قوم من الذين معنا إلى القبر، فوجدوه هكذا كما قالت النساء، وأما يسوع فلم يروه.» فقال لهما يسوع: «يا عديمي الفهم، وبطيبي القلب في الإيمان بكل ما تكلم به الأنبياء! أما كان يجب على المسيح أن يعاني تلك الآلام، ثم يدخل في مجده؟» وفسر لهما ما يتعلق به في كل الكتب المقدسة، مبتدئاً بموسى وجميع الأنبياء. واقتربا من القرية التي كانا ذاهبين إليها، فتظاهرا بيسوع بأنه ذاهب إلى مكان أبعد. فتمسكا به قائلين: «أمكنث معنا، فقد حان المساء، ومال النهار.» فدخل ليملك معهما. وفيما كان منكثاً معهما، أخذ الخبز، وبارك، وكسر، وناولهما. فانفتحت أعينهما، وعرفاه، فإذا هو قد توارى عنهما. فقال أحدهما للآخر: «أما كان قلبنا مضطرباً فيما، حين كان يكلمنا في الطريق، ويشرح لنا الكتب؟» وقاما في تلك الساعة عينها، ورجعا إلى اورشليم، فوجدا الأحد عشر والذين معهم مجتمعين، وهم يقولون: «حقاً إن الرب قام، وترأى لبسيمان.» أما هما فكانا يخبران بما حدث في الطريق، وكيف عرفا يسوع عند كسر الخبز.

The evangelist Luke writes,

On that same day two of them were going to a village called Emmaus, about seven miles from Jerusalem, and talking with each other about all these things that had happened. While they were talking and discussing, Jesus himself came near and went with them, but their eyes were kept from recognizing him. And he said to them, "What are you discussing with each other while you walk along?" They stood still, looking sad. Then one of them, whose name was Cleopas, answered him, "Are you the only stranger in Jerusalem who does not know the things that have taken place there in these days?" He asked them, "What things?" They replied, "The things about Jesus of Nazareth, who was a prophet mighty in deed and word before God and all the people, and how our chief priests and leaders handed him over to be condemned to death and crucified him. But we had hoped that he was the one to redeem Israel. Yes, and besides all this, it is now the third day since these things took place. Moreover, some women of our group astounded us. They were at the tomb early this morning, and when they did not find his body there, they came back and told us that they had indeed seen a vision of angels who said that he was alive. Some of those who were with us went to the tomb and found it just as the women had said; but they did not see him." Then he said to them, "Oh, how foolish you are, and how slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have declared! Was it not necessary that the Messiah should suffer these things and then enter into his glory?" Then beginning with Moses and all the prophets, he interpreted to them the things about himself in all the scriptures. As they came near the village to which they were going, he walked ahead as if he were going on. But they urged him strongly, saying, "Stay with us, because it is almost evening and the day is now nearly over." So he went in to stay with them. When he was at the table with them, he took bread, blessed and broke it, and gave it to them. Then their eyes were opened, and they recognized him; and he vanished from their sight. They said to each other, "Were not our hearts burning within us while he was talking to us on the road, while he was opening the scriptures to us?" That same hour they got up and returned to Jerusalem; and they found the eleven and their companions gathered together. They were saying, "The Lord has risen indeed, and he has appeared to Simon!" Then they told what had happened on the road, and how he had been made known to them in the breaking of the bread.

This is the truth! Peace be with you.



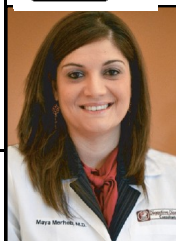
