Fourth Sunday of the Resurrection

After the "scandal" of the Cross the disciples had returned to their land and to their work as fishermen, that is, to those activities they carried out before meeting Jesus. They had returned to their former life and this suggests the climate of dispersion and bewilderment that reigned in their community. It was difficult for the disciples to understand what had happened. Peter has too much pain in his heart, his path is too unsuccessful. The fact of having denied Jesus before a servant has thrown him into utter despair. Go back to fishing, picking up those nets he left three years earlier to start the mad adventure with the Lord. The usual friends follow him, they are with him to encourage and support him. But, as often happens, insult is added to the damage: he doesn't catch anything during the night and everyone's mood is now black.

However, while everything seemed finished, again, as on the way of Emmaus, it is still Jesus who comes to his friends. This time he meets them on the sea, a place which brings to mind the difficulties and tribulations of life; he met them in the morning, after a useless effort which lasted the whole night. The "dawn" in the Bible often indicates the moment of extraordinary interventions of God. It is at daybreak that Mary Magdalene and the other women who rushed to the tomb meet the risen Lord. Even in the Gospel passage that we are meditating, the night has now passed and to the disciples tired by fatigue, disappointed not to have caught anything, the Lord says: "Throw the net on the right side of the boat you will find!" Normally the fish fall into the net during the night, when it is dark, and not in the morning, when the water is now transparent. However, the disciples trusted Jesus and the result was a miraculously abundant fishing, so much so that they could no longer pull up the net for large quantities of fish collected.

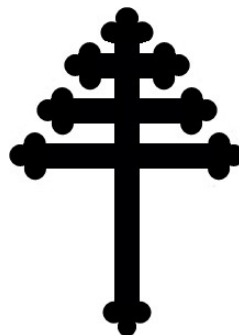
At the end of each unsuccessful night, at the end of every night, at the end of every disappointment, where we live, the Lord awaits us. With grace and delicacy, he invites Peter and the others to take off again, to cast the net on the weak side of their lives. We too, like the disciples, are very depressed and tired and our work is unsuccessful. We spend days and weeks with no results, we do not tire but we know it well that Jesus is close to us. The important thing is to listen to his voice and do what he tells us.

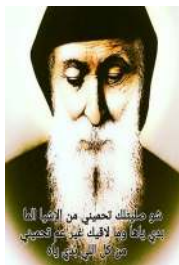

After these things Jesus showed himself again to the disciples by the Sea of Tiberias; and he showed himself in this way. Gathered there together were Simon Peter, Thomas called the Twin, Nathanael of Cana in Galilee, the sons of Zebedee, and two others of his disciples. Simon Peter said to them, "I am going fishing." They said to him, "We will go with you." They went out and got into the boat, but that night they caught nothing. Just after daybreak, Jesus stood on the beach; but the disciples did not know that it was Jesus. Jesus said to them, "Children, you have no fish, have you?" They answered him, "No." He said to them, "Cast the net to the right side of the boat, and you will find some." So they cast it, and now they were not able to haul it in because there were so many fish. That disciple whom Jesus loved said to Peter, "It is the Lord!" When Simon Peter heard that it was the Lord, he put on some clothes, for he was naked, and jumped into the sea.

But the other disciples came in the boat, dragging the net full of fish, for they were not far from the land, only about a hundred yards off. When they had gone ashore, they saw a charcoal fire there, with fish on it, and bread. Jesus said to them, "Bring some of the fish that you have just caught." So Simon Peter went aboard and hauled the net ashore, full of large fish, a hundred fifty-three of them; and though there were so many, the net was not torn. Jesus said to them, "Come and have breakfast." Now none of the disciples dared to ask him, "Who are you?" because they knew it was the Lord. Jesus came and took the bread and gave it to them, and did the same with the fish. This was now the third time that Jesus appeared to the disciples after he was raised from the dead. **This is the truth! Peace be with you.**

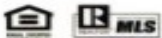
